

## **Request for Early Reinstatement Instructions**

University policy states that all students dismissed for the first time must sit out for one full semester (Fall/Summer/Spring) before returning. However, students who have a **documented**, **non-academic**, **extenuating circumstance** which prevented their academic success may petition for early reinstatement back into the University immediately.

## Early reinstatements are very rare—most appeals are denied.

To be considered, students <u>must</u> submit the following information to the College of Sciences Associate Dean for Undergraduate Studies, via email to <u>cos.undergraduate@utsa.edu</u>.

- Typed letter (maximum of 2 pages) in which you explain the circumstances that prevented your academic success. The circumstances should be **extenuating**, **temporary**, **non-academic**, **and documented**.
  - In the header, include your Full Name, myUTSA ID, Major, and UTSA Email.
  - The letter should also include your responses to these two questions:
    - What will change for you academically next semester?
    - What strategies or resources will you use to aid your success next semester?
- Official documentation of the **non-academic**, **severe**, **extenuating circumstance**. Documented circumstances must have *directly affected you*, *been severe*, *ongoing*, and must *no longer be impacting* your success.

## Incomplete packets will not be accepted.

## Submission Deadline:

The deadline to submit a complete appeal packet for early reinstatement to the College of Sciences via email to <u>cos.undergraduate@utsa.edu</u>, is no later than 1 week before classes begin for the semester. You will be notified via your UTSA email address when a decision has been made.
