

Request for Early Reinstatement

<u>University Policy on Academic Standing</u> states that all students who are placed on academic dismissal may petition for readmission only after sitting out the required time (one semester – fall, spring, or summer – for first dismissals.) However, students who have a **documented**, **non-academic**, **temporary**, **extenuating circumstance** which prevented their academic success may petition for early reinstatement back into the University immediately.

Early reinstatements are very rare — most appeals are denied.

Incomplete requests and late requests will not be accepted for consideration; the submission deadline is 1 week before classes begin for the semester.

To be considered, students must submit the following information to the College of Sciences Associate Dean for Undergraduate Studies, via email to COSUndergraduateStudies@utsa.edu:

- Typed statement (maximum of 1 page) in which you explain the circumstances that
 prevented your academic success. The circumstances should be documented, nonacademic, temporary, and extenuating. Also include what will change for you academically
 and what strategies you will use to be successful in the next term.
- Official documentation of the non-academic, temporary, and extenuating circumstances.
 Documented circumstances must have directly affected you, been severe, ongoing, and must no longer be impacting your success.
