ABSTRACT

As urbanization accelerates, the need for innovative and sustainable infrastructure becomes increasingly urgent. Nature-based solutions (NbS) offer a powerful approach to addressing environmental challenges enhancing resilience while in urban landscapes. This presentation explores the River Authority's past and current efforts to promote Nature-based Solutions through our NbS program and other efforts. Through our inaugural project at Graytown Park, we will examine the design & implementation process. ecological benefits, and long-term sustainability of these solutions, providing insights into how collaboration interdisciplinary and advanced engineering techniques can create greener, more adaptive landscapes.
