#### **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must:

- 1. Be enrolled as a junior or senior in the UTSA Department of Environmental Science and Ecology;
- 2. Commit to attending workshops, mentoring sessions, social events, science communication activities, and other functions as requested;
- 3. Commit to participate in end-of-year program assessments and focus groups.
- 4. Cumulative GPA of 2.75 and GPA of 3.0 within major.
